BEFORE the meeting

- **Sign up** in advance with the leader of the meeting.
- **Bring a mask** or cloth face-covering like a bandana or scarf.
- Stay at home if you feel sick or your temperature is above 100°F.

AT the meeting

- Enter the courtyard (between the church nave and the parish hall) from the parking lot. Do NOT enter the building.
- We will **check your temperature** quickly and contactless. Your temperature has to be below 100°F to attend the meeting.
- **Sanitize** your hands. We are providing hand sanitizer.
- **Sign in** and add your contact information to the participant list.
- **Wear your mask** at all times. We can provide one.
- **Keep social distance** and stay 6 feet apart.

AFTER the meeting

- **Sanitize** your hands.
- Inform us if you are getting sick or are tested positive for COVID-19.
